Thank you for your faithful prayer and support of CGF! Over the past year, our 19 staff sought to abide in Christ and witnessed the Lord produce the following fruit:

- 20 college golfers helped plant churches on a mission trip to Costa Rica.
- 400 tournament and campus visits where staff ministered to thousands of college golfers and coaches.
- 500 college golfers met in weekly Bible studies and discipleship groups.
- 900 college golfers attended a CGF Retreat.
- 5,000 college golfers exposed to the Gospel through CGF outreach activities.

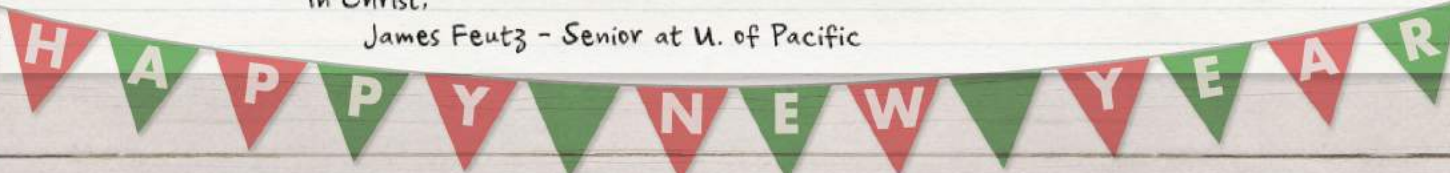
